REPORT ON THE SECOND REGIONAL SYMPOSIUM ON ELECTROCHEMISTRY OF SOUTH-EAST EUROPE

Second Regional Symposium on Electrochemistry of South-East Europe (2nd RSE SEE) was held in Belgrade, Main Hall of “Sava” Centre from 6th – 10th June 2010. The Symposium was attended by 190 participants from 27 countries all over the world. Nine Plenary lectures were presented at the Symposium, given by B.M. Grafov (Russia), C.G. Vayenas (Greece), C. Comninellis (Swiss), P.L. Bonora, L. Fedrizzi and P.L. Cavallotti (Italy), I. Milošev (Slovenia) and V. Stamenković (USA). A part from Plenary lectures 18 Key Note Lectures, 47 Oral Presentations and 129 Poster Presentations were presented at the Symposium in 12 sessions: Bioelectrochemistry and Biomedical Applications; Corrosion, Passivation and Anodic Films; Energy Conversion and Storage Devices; Environmental Electrochemistry; Electrochemical and Electronic Sensor Devices; Experimental and Theoretical Methods in Electrochemistry; Electrochemistry of Functional Structures and Materials; Nanoscale and Molecular Electrochemistry; Organic Electrochemistry; Physical Electrochemistry and Analytical Electrochemistry; Electrochemical Synthesis, Deposition, Electrolysis and Engineering and General Electrochemistry.
